





Meningitis Vaccination



If attending Texas Southern University, the state of Texas requires you to submit proof of vaccination against bacterial meningitis. You may not get a class schedule, or enroll, at Texas Southern University without proof of this immunization.

- If you are 21 years of age or younger and entering TSU for the first time you MUST submit proof of the meningitis vaccination.
- > If you are 21 years of age or younger and returning to TSU after a break in enrollment of one fall/spring semester you MUST submit proof of the meningitis vaccination.

Your Class Schedule

Did you know that you do not have to wait for orientation to get your class schedule? You just have to complete the following:

- > Speak with your Freshman Advisor and get advised on your Fall 2021 classes
- Submit your TSI Scores
- Submit your Meningitis Vaccination

Housing

Texas Southern University recommends that all freshmen students reside in on-campus housing.

Scholarships

TSU offers renewable merit-based scholarships to incoming freshmen and transfer students based on:

- Standardized test scores (ACT/SAT) and high school [for freshmen]
- Transfer cumulative grade point average (GPA) [for transfer students]

Award amount varies. The scholarship application priority deadline for the fall semester is March 1st.

For scholarship consideration, students must:

- ➤ Be admitted to the university
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

What Happens at a Registration Day?

Get Admin Help

Submit outstanding items to Admissions, talk with Financial Aid, Student Accounting, and get a meningitis vaccination.

Get Some Culture

Meet some students and staff who can help you get to know YOUR university.

Freshman Advisors

Meet your Freshman Advisors and learn about the First Year Experience.

They will advise you and help you register for classes.

Q: Do I have to register for a Registration Day?

A: Yes. Registration is mandatory to ensure a safe event for all. www.tsufreshman.com

Q: What COVID safety measures have you taken?

A: Each day is broken down into 5 registration sessions to ensure attendees are well below the reccomended number for building occupancy. The building is sanitized between sessions. All are required to wear masks and get their temperature taken upon entering the building.

Q: Can my friends come with me?

A: Only if they are registered for the same time and day.

Q: Can my parent(s)/guardian(s) come?

A: No. For the safety of all, only the registered student will be allowed in the building.

Q: Where do I park?

A: Park in the S-1 lot and follow the signs to the Fairchild Building.

Q: Can I get my schedule online instead? I don't feel comfortable coming in.

A: Yes! Starting in April, your advisor can get you registered virtually.



FERPA or **The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act** is a Federal law that protects the privacy of student education records. The law applies to all schools that receive funds under an applicable program of the U.S. Department of Education.

FERPA gives parents certain rights with respect to their student's education records. Parents or eligible students have the right to inspect and review the student's education records maintained by the school. (www2.ed.gov)

What does this mean?

To share information about your student account, including financial or academic details, with your parent or guardian we have to have a FERPA on file.


All new students must take the Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Assessment Exam to be placed in their college level English & Math course without a lab.
